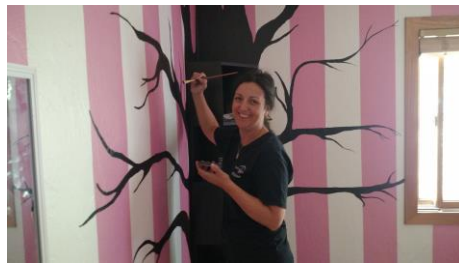
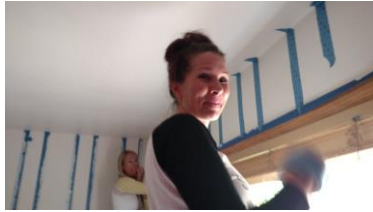
Special call out to Stan Bochenek shown to the right with his son Brennan.
