Mom & Dad Bought Her A Trampoline For Indoors



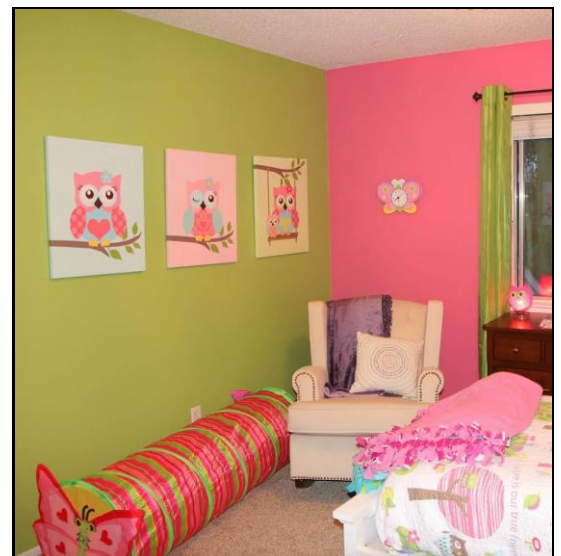
Finally, The Family Has A Table To Eat Together...

Scarlette Is Surrounded By Love From So Many People Who Care!**

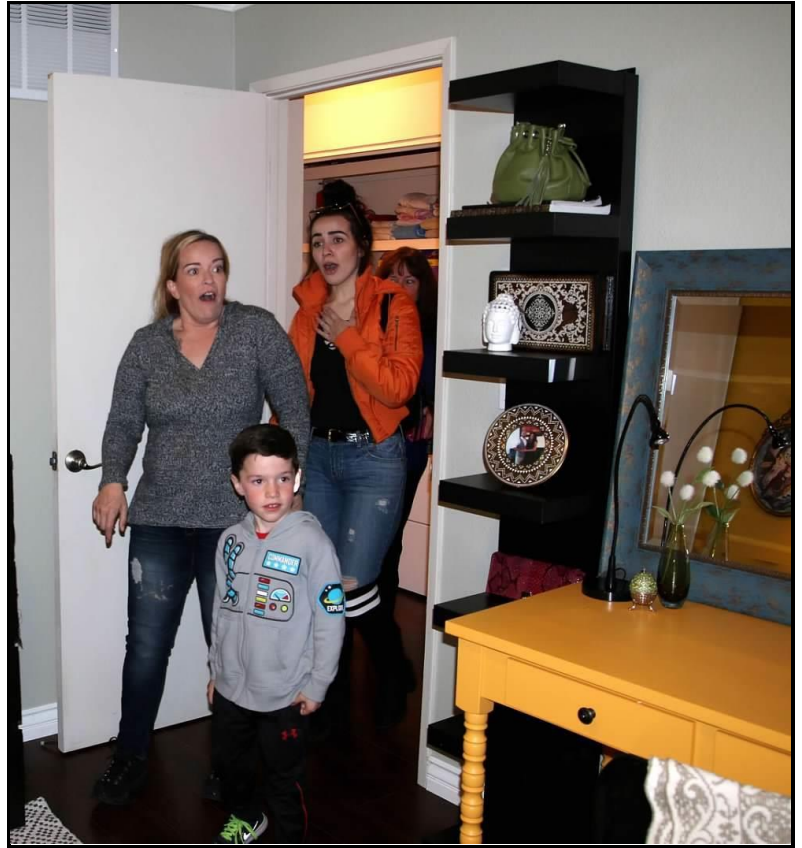


And Scarlett's Sister, Alisa...
